


A Beautiful NEW Sign

And let's not forget that she secured a tax exemption, **saving us \$8,200 every year, starting in 2026.**

In her past life, Helen was a mail carrier for fifteen years, was her husband's right-hand for their construction business, and ran a farm for thirty years. She loves gardening and raising her own food.
