Greg donated all the new LED light fixtures in the clubhouse and the range (which are significantly brighter and more energy-efficient than the fluorescent lights we had). Mike assisted with the install, and Don did all the wiring. To provide lighting above each port, Greg purchased an LED strip, and Rich cut the wood to mount it to. The switch to turn them on is next to Port #1. Unplug the short-range light on the switch if you are not using it.

## Range door lock

We want to clarify how the range door lock works. Some members have manually locked the door, thinking the magnetic lock is not working. The magnetic lock WILL NOT engage while you are standing under the sensor above the door. Once you step outside, you can test that the magnet lock has engaged.

**This month, we highlight John Worobock**

If you attend meetings, you have seen John sitting in the front corner, proudly wearing his Marine Veteran cap. John grew up on his family farm in Pine Island, NY. He enlisted in the Marines with a couple of his best friends at 18 in 1955 and served until 1960, at the beginning of the Vietnam War. He was going to reenlist, but in the back of his mind, he kept thinking, "There's NO place like home!" He returned to the States and has lived in Vernon for the past 63 years. His career started when he got a call from a friend insisting he come over to help him clear some trees, and he has been a tree cutter ever since.

Over the years, John has donated his bucket truck and time, along with **Jim Williams**, to many tree-clearing (especially on the 75-yard line) and wiring projects at the Club. He's been a member for over 25 years, joining after he met John Heller's sister, who was waitressing at the Jolly Onion Inn in Pine Island.

## Insurance savings

After our property insurance carrier increased our annual premium over the last three years from \$3,286 to \$6,062 and then to \$7,030, the Club began looking for ways to reduce these costs. With help from **Jim Williams** and a lot of back-and-forth work with our liability insurance carrier to define realistic replacement costs, we switched carriers. Our new premium is now \$2,925, **a savings of \$4,105 per year**. Thank you to all involved for your hard work on this!.
